PROGRAM REVIEW

- The CAEP/NCATE accreditation process has two primary components: the EPP (Educator Preparation Provider) unit review and the program review.
- A program is a discipline-specific component within a unit that provides a planned sequence of courses and experiences for preparing P-12 teachers.
- Programs reports entails the submission of 8 or less assessments that provide evidence of candidate mastery of specialized professional associations (SPA) Standards. (i.e. NCTE, NCTM, CEC) EPP assessments are aligned to the SPA standards.
- The number of required assessments depends on which option (A, B, C, D) the EPP chooses to use to submit their program reports.
- These courses and assessments often lead to a recommendation for a state license to work in schools.
