Assistant Vice Chancellor, Teacher Education & Public School Programs

The California State University, Office of the Chancellor, is seeking an Assistant Vice Chancellor, Teacher Education & Public School Programs to provide vision and support for California State University (CSU) system's commitment to prepare more high quality teachers for California's P-12 sector. The incumbent is responsible for leading, coordinating, and expediting systemwide efforts to recruit and prepare more teachers, improve the quality of the teachers prepared, and coordinate P-18 programs, especially CSU's contributions to P-12 reform. The incumbent is also responsible for representing the CSU in numerous leadership roles around the state and nation, for contributions to statewide policy discussion and decisions.

The successful candidate is required to have a doctoral degree from an accredited university and teaching experience; a minimum of ten years of service as an academic administrator is required that includes a strong record of project administration; a minimum of five years of experience with applying for and managing funds from external sources; a minimum of ten years in personnel management experience; supervisory experience is required; higher education experience is required; broad experience in the CSU is highly preferred; excellent organizational skills and demonstrated ability to plan, organize, coordinate and direct

multiple projects and activities with competing deadlines, and to set and manage timelines and priorities; ability to utilize sound judgment, and ensure the utmost discretion and confidentiality in all matters; incumbent will need thorough understanding of teacher education and the CSU system, as well as familiarity with California public education; the incumbent will also have strong ongoing familiarity of national issues and trends surrounding teacher education and the ability to serve as an advocate on teacher education topics; well-developed written and oral communication skills will be essential; well-developed organizational and political skills.
