- At least six years of experience in higher education with demonstrated excellence in teaching, scholarship, and service.
- Evidence of effective leadership in roles such as department chair, program director, or similar.
- A sustained research agenda with a focus on educational literacy, leadership, or a closely related area of study.
- Experience mentoring and advising graduate and doctoral students, including dissertation supervision.
