Serving as the academic leader of the School of Education, the Dean plays an essential role in carrying out the vision, mission and strategic plan of the institution. The Dean has responsibility for planning, budgeting, scheduling, personnel matters, curriculum, instruction, and development and revision of academic programs. The Dean works collaboratively with Brandman University administration, reporting to the Executive Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs. Candidates should have substantial experience in an academic environment, including exposure to and knowledge of academic issues including enrollment, student advisement, accreditation compliance and curriculum development. A minimum of five years effective academic administrative experience as a Department Chair, Program Director, Associate/Assistant Dean, or Dean, with demonstrated understanding of systems, administration, strategic planning, effective fiscal management, and personnel supervision is required. Experience with online course delivery is required and experience in a distributed campus environment is preferred. Ideally, candidates will have experience with educational program review and accreditation, as well as experience in student recruitment, retention, marketing, and promotion. Experience in California would be a plus.
