Touro College seeks a Dean for its Graduate School of Education (GSE) who will provide strategic, transformational leadership and vision. The Dean will play a key role in designing and implementing a framework to ensure the economic and intellectual viability of the School. We are seeking a dean who: Inspires and supports the success of students, faculty and staff; Engages with the local and professional community to forge educational partnerships; Builds on the strengths of the current programs and on recent GSE restructuring by working collaboratively with faculty and program chairs to enhance the school's regional prominence and attract external support for the school; Oversees academic quality and faculty evaluation; Leads the accreditation process, outreach, and scholarly activities; Identifies emerging opportunities and implements interdisciplinary and cross-unit collaborations; and effectively cultivates donors, funders and manages the budget.

The Dean of the Graduate School of Education works in collaboration with the College faculty, Touro administration, and the New York community--including educators, business leaders, legislators, and benefactors--to set the strategic priorities for the School. The position requires experience with the complex issues affecting education in our nation today and a record of achievement in improving the quality of education for teachers and administrators. The Dean reports to the Vice President of the Division of Graduate Studies.

Candidates must have an earned doctorate in education or in a field closely related to education; an earned rank of associate or full professor, with tenure, at an accredited college or university; and at least three years senior supervisory experience including personnel and budget management .

ABOUT THE GRADUATE SCHOOL OF EDUCATION

The mission of the Touro College Graduate School of Education is to prepare a diverse cadre of highly qualified teachers, leaders, knowledge developers, and disseminators. This mission is in keeping with Touro's Judaic commitment to social justice, intellectual pursuit, and service to humanity. We strive to educate teachers and school leaders who are distinguished by their academic expertise, ethics, and commitment to providing educational opportunities to the broad spectrum of society.

Founded in 1993, the Graduate School of Education offers eight graduate degree programs and multiple certificate programs leading to NY state certification. Our current enrollment is approximately 3,000, making us one of the largest educator preparation providers in New York City. We have locations in Manhattan, Queens, Brooklyn, Staten Island, Long Island, and Westchester, and we also offer online programs.

Nationally, Touro ranks eighth in the nation for awarding the most master's degrees in education to minorities. Statewide, Touro ranks among the top 5 for awarding graduate degrees in education to Hispanics, African Americans, and Asian Americans. The GSE is a leading provider of teachers to the NYC

public schools, and one of the largest providers of teachers to "high need" schools; and the GSE is a leading NY graduate teacher education program in the number of first-year NY City classroom teachers recommended for certification, particularly in the highest need license areas.

The Graduate School of Education is part of the Touro College and University System, a system of non-profit institutions of higher and professional education. Touro College was chartered in 1979 primarily to enrich the Jewish heritage, and to serve the larger American and global community.
