The School of Education at the University of Delaware invites nominations and applications for its Director. We seek a visionary senior scholar with a well-established research program who can provide strong, dynamic, and innovative leadership to promote the School's research, teaching, and clinical practice, as well as advance its reputation and national visibility. The successful candidate will bring imaginative leadership and an open mind to strategic and budget planning, look for opportunities to build on the School's current strengths and develop new collaborations, support high standards needed to help the School enhance the quality of its research and instruction, support the development and success of online degree programs, and support global initiatives and innovative education. We are particularly interested in candidates who have demonstrated a commitment to excellence by promoting diversity and equal opportunities through leadership in research, inclusive teaching, and public engagement or outreach. We especially encourage scholars from underrepresented groups to apply.

The successful candidate will have a doctorate in education or a related field, a distinguished record of scholarship, a commitment to excellence in instruction, a willingness to prioritize policies and programs that promote inclusive excellence and success for all students, and sufficient experience to indicate the ability to work cooperatively and effectively with faculty, staff, and administrators within the School, other units in the College, and the University. The successful candidate will be qualified for appointment at the professor level in a tenure-line position.

UD is home to the College of Education and Human Development which is known nationally for its innovative, exemplary School of Education. With external funding of \$25 million per year from 2012-16, the College ranks among the top universities in federal support for education research. The School houses the College's largest undergraduate program, Elementary Teacher Education, a model program with extensive interdisciplinary, applied experiences. The School also houses several professional master's degree programs and PhD and EdD programs. In 2014, the School launched a new online masters program in teacher leadership, and is actively developing additional online degree programs.

The salary is competitive, commensurate with experience and qualifications. Relocation and research start-up costs are available. The Director position is a five-year renewable appointment with a start date of September 1, 2017.
