Given the accreditation process is grounded in gathering data, reviewing evidence, and interviewing stakeholders, teams have to be flexible in how they engage within the virtual space. With the transition to remote reviews, the fidelity and rigor of the accreditation process remains paramount. CAEP accreditation continues to ensure institutions, students, and stakeholders have confidence that the EPP is preparing high-quality educators to strengthen P-12 student learning.
